

# TRANSFER GUIDE

A.A. in Art History and Museum Studies

| B.A. in Visual and Material Culture

This transfer guide is intended for students pursuing an Associate of Arts in Visual Arts Transfer with a concentration in Art History and Museum Studies at Anne Arundel Community College who are interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Arts in Visual and Material Culture at the Goucher College. This transfer guide demonstrates how a student can meet both requirements for the associate and bachelor degrees.

## SAVINGS:

Students can save up to \$70,176.00 by completing their associate degree at Anne Arundel Community College and then finishing up at Goucher College (based on average costs 2020-21).

## GOUCHER NOTES:

- Goucher accepts up to 60 credits from AACC.
- Students will need to submit (2) written papers to determine College Writing Proficiency placement :

- A 3-week study abroad requirement should be completed either January 2021 or summer 2021 (4 credits).
- A 7-week physical activity requirement (0 credit) must be completed if not already fulfilled.
